Falcon show: Hunting with hawks is one of the most unique features of the Kazakh way of life. We invite you to visit the spectacular show with specially trained hunting birds and learn more about the traditions and history.

In Kazakhstan, hunters with eagles are called «berkutchi». The training experience of wild birds handed down from father to son for centuries and kept in secrecy. These masters have native talent for training of wild birds and their activity is not limited by just hunting. Today, the golden eagle is listed among birds threatened with extinction. Together with the environmental service staff the hunters participate in a program of research and monitoring of population of this rare bird in the remote regions of Central Asia.

In Almaty located a nursery of rare endangered species of birds, unique in its species composition and equipment, where we offer you a visit. The nursery is the only one on the entire territory of Kazakhstan and during its operation has grown 1060 birds and released into nature 360 saker falcons.

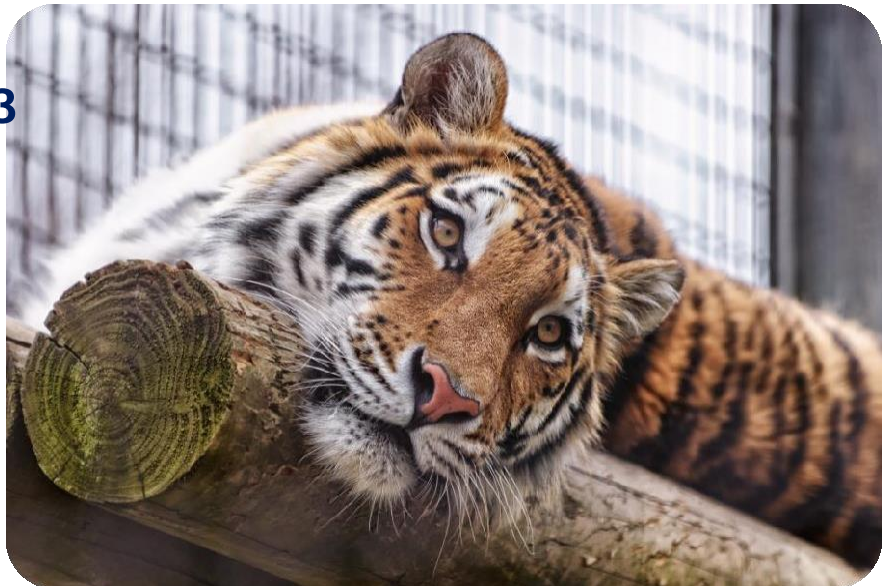

Almaty Zoo is situated to the eastern side of the city in the large park area. See map below. It is one of the oldest zoos in Kazakhstan (now over 75 years old), so tends to be of a traditional layout and design.



Almaty Zoo covers an area of 21 hectares, and has, in its collection, examples of the unique and diverse wildlife of Kazakhstan, in particular, deer, wild ram, wolf, beaver, golden eagle, and others. The collection of animals also exhibits animals from further afield including white and Himalayan bears, tigers, jaguars, Persian and Far Eastern leopards, elephants, zebras, yaks, deer, markhor, American condors, vultures, horned crows, snakes, crocodiles. The total number of species is more than 350 and about 6,000 different animals. The zoo is well attended and loved by the local people, particularly in holiday periods.

In June 2014, Mayor of Almaty Akhmetzhan Yesimov approved the preliminary design of the Dolphinarium in the Park. The area of the facility will be around 1,000 square meters and will have 750 seats.

“It will be a dedicated, year-round, large and beautiful facility that meets all the standards of animal management. We will move there in six months. Now, the construction work is underway. (...) We hired highly qualified specialists, and are installing modern equipment. The water is cleaner than in the sea, and the solution is ideal for the animals,” said Vitaly Staragin, Director of marketing and PR of Nemo international dolphinarium network.

When we move into the stationary pavillion, we also want to bring a dolphin white whale. From time to time we will be bringing new animals and it will be a surprise for our guests,” Staragin said.

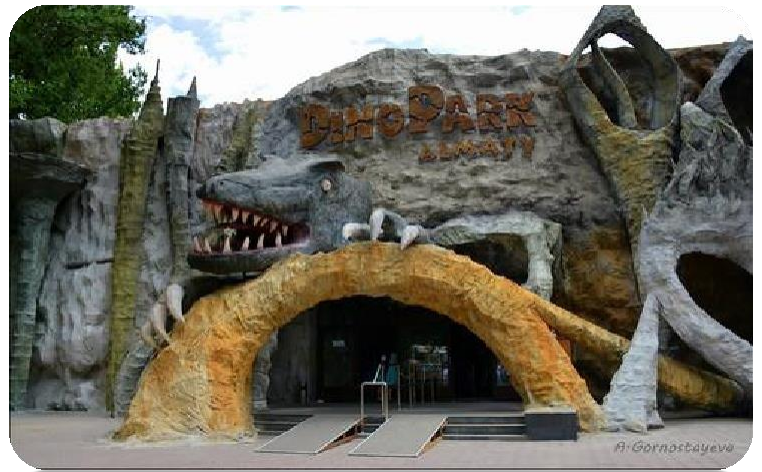

Gorky Park is one of the most popular parks in Almaty and a good recreational space for both Walking and, entertaining the children. The Park is now known by the name of Central Park and covers an area of 100 Hectares. . The location of the park, as it suggests, is in central Almaty and is close to the Green Bazaar and also Panfilov Park.



Gorky Park was named after the Russian author Maxim Gorky and the locals sometimes refer to the park as Park Gorkogo.

The Park has facilities for all, with Shady walks and shrubs, water features, flower beds and arrangements and in one area, an amusement park for the children with rides on both the fun fair and horses etc.

Some 25km outside Almaty on the way to Kapchagai is the Asanov Shooting Club, named after champion Kazakhstani marksman Alexander Asanov. Here it's possible to shoot clay pigeons (skeet), gun hire and a (Russian-speaking) instructor.

The club also organises luxury corporate entertainment and stages shooting displays and contests. There are two clubhouses with restaurants, one members'-only and one that is open to all; as well as billiards, table tennis and even a children's playground.
